Message to The Church

Dear Brother's and Sister's in Christ Jesus!

May this True Message find all in good health and prospering spiritually. The Word of God says that we should grow in the grace of God and not as Paul preached ever learning and never coming to the truth. This is unfortunately how many so called Preachers hoodwinked and mislead the Church of God.

Paul the great Apostle said in Acts beginning at Act's chapter twenty versus twenty six through verse twenty nine. And the Word of God says, "Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the blood of all men." Can you as a Minister say this? If not, why not? "For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God." Have you the so called Minister of God? Or have you twisted and changed the Word of God to fit your lifestyle or to justify your breaking of Gods holy Word? Are you building as the Word of God has said in Ephesians Chapter two verse twenty? "And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;" Whose foundation are you building on? Or are you doing as the Apostle Peter said in second Peter the third chapter and verse sixteen, "As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction." So as it was then so is it now because Ministers do not want to obey God's law they make up their own set of interpretations of the Word of God.

You may ask why and do they break God's ordinances. I am going to tell you what the Word says, first and foremost about all of God's Ministers.

First a Minister must be called by the Lord Jesus Christ. As you know from the Word of God, Jesus first called the Apostles, than he called another seventy, all had to meet the criteria set forth in first Timothy the third Chapter beginning at verse one "This is as true saying, if a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work. "A Bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality, apt to teach;" Why then when the Word of God explicitly says the husband of one wife why does the Church and its leadership justify many times married Preachers?

If you are a Minister and you have had more than one wife you are doomed.

Is not this building on another foundation contrary to the Word of God. Well they say my wife died and also my wife left me so Paul said in Corinthians I am free. This is not what Paul said, let's look at the Word of God and see what it says. In first Corinthians seventh Chapter Paul is talking about the child of God <u>AND NOT</u> Ministers. Ministers are still bound by first Timothy the third Chapter no matter how much they wrest the scriptures.

If you are a God called Minister, you must remain the husband of one wife OR the wife of one husband ALL of your life otherwise you are breaking God's ordinances. In Galatians the fifth Chapter beginning at verse sixteen it says "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh." Verse nineteen "Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness." Verse twenty "Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies," Verse twenty one "Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God." So you see you can study and read for yourselves that there is no justification for a Minister to have more than one wife living or dead or divorced God said one and he knows the difference between one and any number greater than one.

Let me warn all who read this letter what the Word of God says about joining the wrong. In second John verse nine, ten and eleven it reads "Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son." Verse ten "If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed" Verse Eleven "For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds." This doctrine of the Bible one wife, one husband was brought and delivered to us by God's servants Brother A. G. Etterman and his wife Sister Annie Etterman and it is going to stand till Jesus comes.

<u>I would warn all</u> to not partake of nor condone any double married Preacher unless you wish to the anger of the Most high God. Remember the Word of God says that you don't have to do the deed just have pleasure in those doing the wrong i.e. going to the wedding, congrats to them, buying a present, all are condoning what God said is wrong. And all God's Ministers must uphold the foundation that's been laid and not try to destroy it, if we do the Word of God pronounces a curse on us.
